# THE 58TH ANNUAL BALL OF THE YEAR 2021

is coming!

In an effort to revitalize our West Virginia communities, the Mon Health Medical Center Auxiliary is hosting an Appalachian Revival with a two-day event at Pete Dye Golf Club on August 27 and 28. This will include a VIP Progressive Golf Experience and a Dinner Soirée in the Hills.

The weekend will be dedicated to celebrating our deep heritage and rich talent, with decorations, food and entertainment all being locally sourced. Together, we will explore the best of West Virginia's flavors, art, music and golf. We will also enjoy the luxury of an alfresco dining experience — all nestled in our glorious Appalachian landscape.

Proceeds from this year's event will again support the Progression Through Postpartum Program, or P3. This program was created to support postpartum depression, anxiety and mood disorders, which one in nine mothers experiences after childbirth. As one of only 15 programs in the country, our incredible Women's Health and Family Birthing Center team saw a need in our area.

Now, the team is ready to expand into its own space to provide in-person support groups and outpatient group therapy, rooms for lactation consulting, childcare services, yoga, nutrition, exercise classes and other services as needed. Breaking down barriers on the stigma that surrounds mental health, this program has had an enormous impact in providing guidance for the entire family.



The Mon Health Medical Center Auxiliary is steeped in rich history and accomplishment. Originally chartered as the Auxiliary of Monongalia General Hospital, this volunteer fundraising organization is celebrating its 77th year. There are more than 500 lifetime members, and the group has contributed in excess of \$2 million to the hospital.

The current Auxiliary Board is proud to continue the legacy of the original founders. The 2019 Ball of the Year proceeds totaling \$211,650 were donated to the establishment of P3, which will also benefit from the 2021 Ball of the Year funds. Additionally, the Auxiliary presented the Foundation with a check for \$100,000 in June 2020. This is the first installment of a \$350,000 pledge to the newly established Geriatric Emergency Department.

# MON HEALTH MEDICAL CENTER USES INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY FOR LUNG CANCER DIAGNOSIS

New innovation that holds promise to fight lung cancer can be found at Mon Health Medical Center. Used to view the inside of the lungs and obtain a tissue sample for biopsy, the goal is to enable earlier and more accurate diagnosis of small and hard-to-reach nodules in the periphery of the lung.

This technology integrates the latest advancements in robotics, software, data science and endoscopy (the use of small cameras and tools to enter the body through its natural openings).

Mon Health Medical Center is the first hospital in North Central West Virginia to utilize the platform, which was recently cleared by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

"Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths worldwide, in part because it has no symptoms in its early stages. Because the Monarch Platform provides improved reach, vision and control for bronchoscopic procedures, it holds the potential to help us to make a diagnosis earlier," said Dr. Jaschar Shakuri-Rad, robotic surgeon and Director of Robotic Surgery at Mon Health Medical Center.

"We are excited about the promise of this technology to offer a more hopeful future for our patients with lung cancer."

More than 90% of people diagnosed with lung cancer do not survive the disease, in part because it is often found at an advanced stage. There are a variety of diagnostic options currently available for lung cancer, but all have limitations in accuracy, safety or invasiveness.

These limitations can lead to false positives, false negatives or side effects such as pneumothorax (collapsed lung) and hemorrhage, which may increase healthcare costs and extend hospital stays.

"Early and accurate diagnosis of lung nodules is crucial," explained Mark Gilliam, Chief Administrative Officer at Mon Health Medical Center.

"At Mon Health Medical Center, the use of robotic bronchoscopy will revolutionize the way we are able to treat patients and serve our community."

The Monarch® Platform utilizes a familiar controller-like interface that physicians use to navigate the flexible robotic endoscope to the periphery of the lung with improved reach, vision and control.

Combining traditional endoscopic views into the lung with computer-assisted navigation based on 3D models of the patient's lung anatomy, the Monarch® Platform provides physicians with continuous bronchoscope vision throughout the entire procedure.

# BUCKHANNON TOYOTA FUNDS POSTPARTUM PROGRAM

At Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital



Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital (SJMH) brought the Mon Health Family Birth Center's Progressing Through Postpartum Program (P3) to its community thanks to a supporting gift from Buckhannon Toyota. The program, one of only 15 perinatal depression programs in the nation, provides critical support to mothers and families coping with the stress that can sometimes become overwhelming after childbirth.

"This is an important program for families in our community, and Buckhannon Toyota is pleased to be able to help fund expansion of the support services to Weston and our surrounding communities," said Jason Minsker, President and Dealer of

Buckhannon Toyota. After the successful implementation of the program in Morgantown, the screening tool used to identify perinatal mood disorders was initiated at SJMH in the spring of 2020. All mothers delivering at Stonewall will receive screening and postpartum support. Typically, 25% of those screened require further specialty care.

Through the program's screening and early intervention, Mon Health helps shorten the duration and long-term consequences of untreated mental health issues.

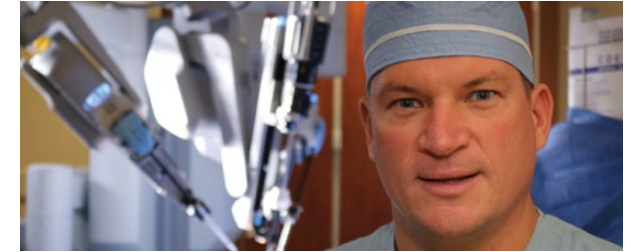

The Mon Health Medical Center Foundation has received a \$294,350 grant from the Hazel Ruby McQuain Charitable Trust to create medical simulation training designed to improve health outcomes and provide continuing education advancement for physicians and staff at the hospital.

The training simulates real-time critical events in the care continuum of a patient, allowing an instructor to control the pace at which an event occurs and pausing at critical points so that learning opportunities are maximized. Structured debriefing occurs after the simulated event, which allows for additional realistic practice and the development of proficiency. "This is state-of-the-art learning and helps to create best practice in caring for patients," said David

# COVID-19 Relief Grants AWARDED TO MON HEALTH MEDICAL CENTER FOUNDATION

A grant for \$200,000 to expand telehealth services for West Virginians and to help offset unexpected expenses related to COVID-19 has been awarded to Mon Health Medical Center from the Milan Puskar Foundation.

Mon Health Medical Center is committed to extending the reach of the telehealth initiative to serve more citizens in need of medical care and to meet the mission of the Milan Puskar Foundation to improve the quality of life for all West Virginians.

"This generous support from the Milan Puskar Foundation is both welcomed and critical during this pandemic," said David Goldberg, President and CEO of Mon Health System. "We've been given \$100,000

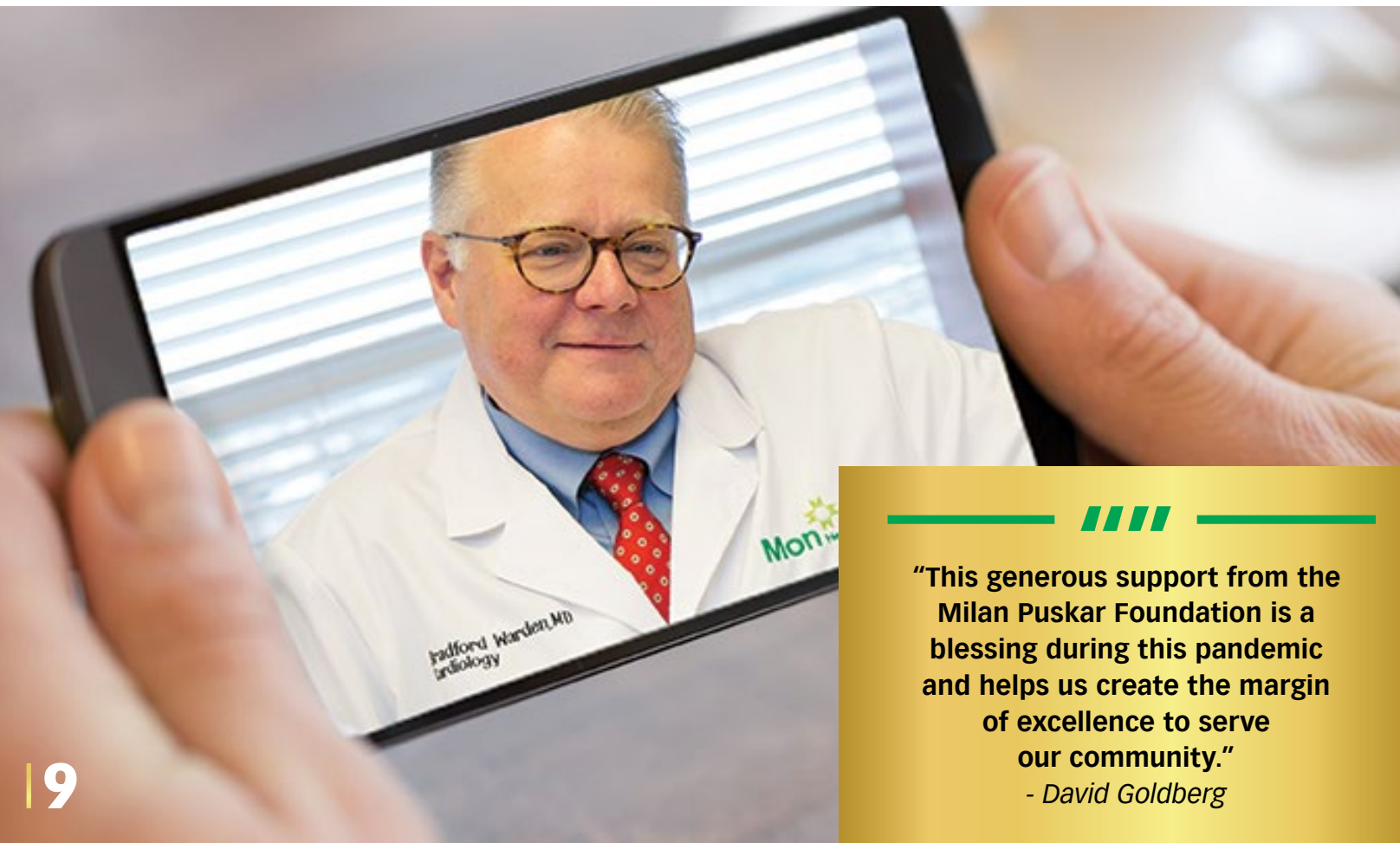
to expand telehealth services at a time of unprecedented need. We've also received \$100,000 to help our health system offset unexpected expenses because of our response to the pandemic. Mon Health has put the safety of our colleagues, patients and visitors first by ensuring we screen visitors, colleagues and patients in an effort to mitigate spread to each other or those coming to us for medical care. This is a significant investment, and we will not end this practice until the pandemic state of emergency ends. Your safety and well-being are our top priority."

COVID-19 has stretched hospital resources and disrupted the lives of West Virginian citizens. Expanding telehealth services will make access to care easier for citizens and allow

medical personnel to serve those citizens better and more safely.

Unexpected expenses include increasing need for PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), traveling nurses, establishing COVID-19 screening staff and testing sites.

"The Milan Puskar Foundation has a history of investing in programs to improve the quality of life for West Virginia citizens, and this is a moment of great need," said Mark Gilliam, Chief Administrative Officer for Mon Health Medical Center and Chief Information Officer for Mon Health System. "With Mon Health, we have great community partners stepping up to answer the call in the fight against COVID-19."

The Health Career Scholarship Program was created in 1991 to promote careers in healthcare in fields with projected shortages in our service area. Since the establishment of the program, the Foundation has awarded over \$700,000.

The scholarships are valued at \$1,000 per year for up to four years. Selection is based on the application, academic performance and financial need. Each applicant submits a letter describing why they chose a specific health career. A subcommittee of the Foundation's Board of Directors selects the recipients.
