It is an OSHA requirement for all containers to have labels for knowledge of what is within & whether it could cause harm. It is best, if possible, to utilize an original container from the manufacturer that contains the label. Per the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, a signal word, pictogram, hazard & precautionary statements, product identifier, & supplier identification are required on the label.
